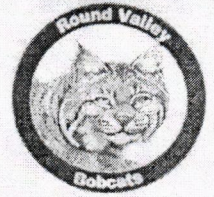

Public Notice:

At the July 1, 2026 Governing Board meeting for Round Valley Joint Elementary School District, the Board accepted the resignation for Board member Jeff Perry and approved the immediate appointment of district resident Josey Roen.

Per Education Code 5092:

Unless a petition calling for a special election pursuant to Education Code 5091 is filed in the office of the County Superintendent of Schools within 30 days of the provisional appointment, the appointment shall become effective.

The person appointed shall only hold office until the next regularly scheduled election for district Board members (Education Code 5091).

If within 30 days of the Board's appointment, registered voters of the district or, where elections are by trustee area, submit a petition for special election that the County Superintendent determines to be legally sufficient, the provisional appointment is terminated, and a special election shall be held in accordance with Education Code 5091 to fill the vacancy.
